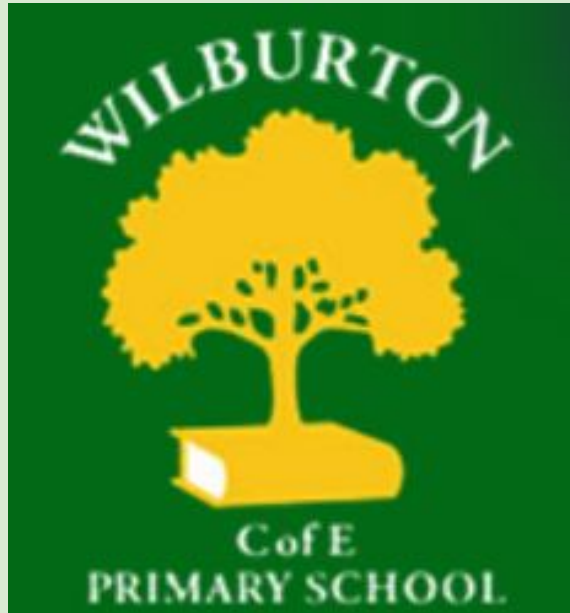


Owls Class - everything you need to know!

Uniform

You can wear trousers, shorts, skirts, dresses, playsuits but you can only wear leggings or tight fitting shorts under your uniform.

Our PE days are Mondays and Thursdays, straight after lunch.

Outdoor Curriculum

You need to be prepared to be outside in all weathers.

This means wearing comfortable shoes which you can run in; having a waterproof coat and wellies or walking boots in school every day; bringing gardening gloves for the allotment; and having a water bottle in school everyday. You will be told when you are going to the allotment.

We will no longer be using Mathletics.

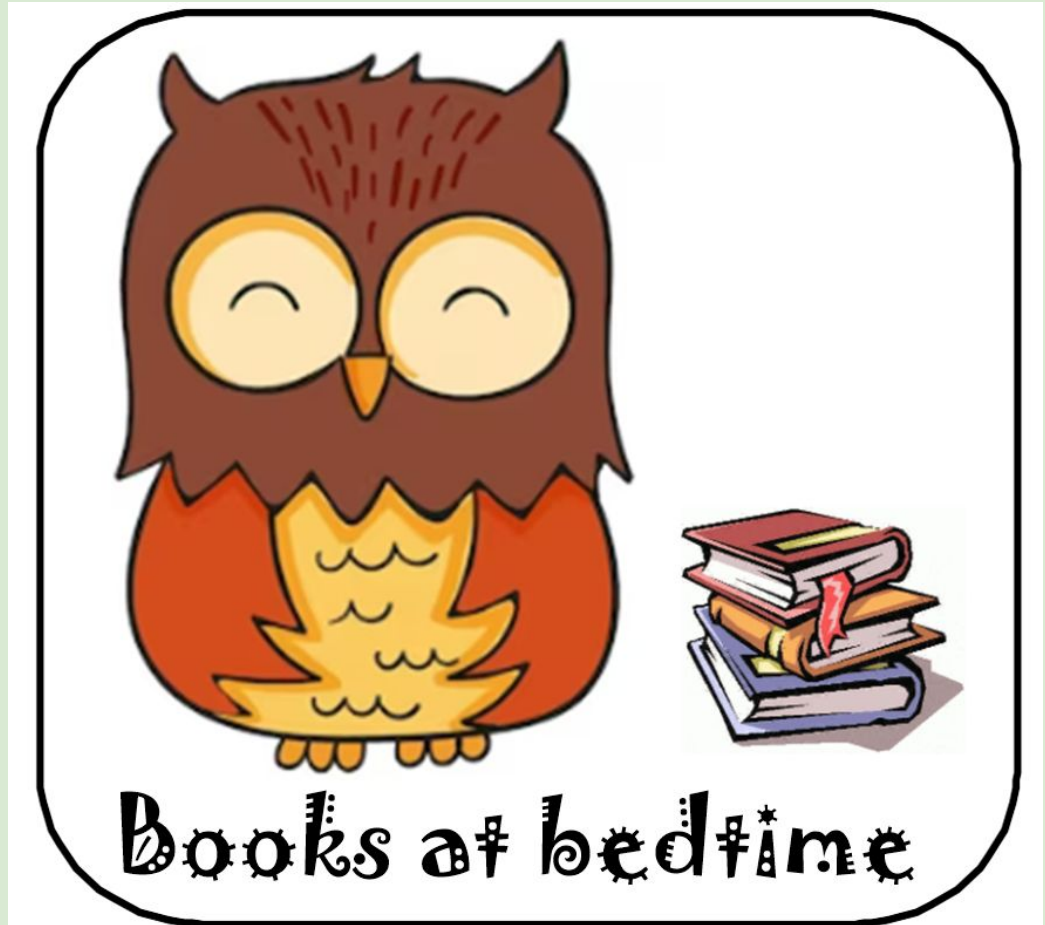
Instead, we'll be using **Maths Flex** which is better because it's more engaging and it adapts the questions to match what you need to learn.
