What is bullying?

Bullying is when someone is verbally or physically threatened, hurt or upset by another child or group of children *over and over again*.

What do we do to stop bullying?

- We teach everyone about our school values and how we treat each other.
- We learn about friendships and relationships in PSHE.
- We learn about what bullying is and what we should do if it happens to us.
- The adults look out for bullying and listen to anyone who is being bullied.
- We tell a teacher if we are being bullied.
- We tell a teacher if we think someone else is being bullied.
- We record all allegations of bullying and assign a member of staff to investigate.
- We follow the steps in our Peace Path, or Support Group Method.
- We monitor how things are going afterwards.
